Civil Rights Complaint vs. Mount Sinai Health System for Illegal Discrimination on the Basis of Race, Color, or National Origin

Mount Sinai Health System offers, operates, funds, hosts and administers the annual discriminatory <u>Mount Sinai Administrative Fellowship Program</u>. From the Fellowship Program Overview section of the program website (bold highlight added):

To develop a focused pathway into healthcare leadership roles for underrepresented minorities, our two-year Administrative Fellowship Program offers challenging, hands-on administrative experiences to individuals who are at the start of their careers in healthcare administration and:

- are **recent graduates** of master's degree programs, graduating in either 2023 or 2024.
- self-identify as a member of a racial/ethnic group that is historically underrepresented in healthcare leadership - specifically Black/African American, Hispanic/Latinx, Native American (American Indian or Alaskan Native), and/or Pacific Islander (one who has origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands).

From the Application Requirement section of the program website:

All prospective fellows must: self-identify as a member of a racial/ethnic group that is historically underrepresented in healthcare leadership - specifically Black/African American, Hispanic/Latinx, Native American (American Indian or Alaskan Native), and/or Pacific Islander (one who has origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa, or other Pacific Islands).

In violation of <u>New York City Human Rights Law</u> that prohibits discrimination in employment, housing, and public accommodations based on race, color, religion/creed, age, national origin, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation,

etc. the Mt. Sinai Health System's <u>Mount Sinai Administrative Fellowship Program</u> illegally excludes individuals who are not Black, Hispanic, Native American, or Pacific Islander (i.e., individuals who are Asian, white and Middle Eastern/North African) on the basis of their race, color or national origin. Please investigate Mt. Sinai Health System for illegal discrimination based on race, color, or national origin.
